Our Marcum-Illinois Families,

The Sutter County Health Department is unable to process our application for a waiver to open the school at this time. The California Department of Public Health has set guidelines that the county must meet before it can consider our waiver request.

"CDPH recommends that schools within jurisdictions with 14-day case rates more than two times the threshold to be on the County Monitoring List (>200 cases per/100,000 population) should not be considered for a waiver to re-open in-person instruction."

What does this mean for our Marcum Families?

- All students in grades TK-8th grade will start school on distance learning.
- The Marcum School Board has voted to move the start date to the 26th of August.
- Marcum School will apply for the waiver for our students to return as soon as the county meets the criteria for reopening of schools under a waiver
- Distance learning schedules for your students will be sent out by 8/14/20
- The school reopening plan will be sent to our parents and posted on our website this week.
- Marcum will hold a virtual Back to School night on 8/19/20
- Individual meetings with teachers, students, and parents will be held at the school following guidelines. You will be given an opportunity to sign up for the following days 8/20, 8/21, and 8/24. The meetings will be held between 9 am and 3 pm.
- Chromebooks are available to any student who needs to have a device.
