1. Call to Order

 - a. 21-22 CAASPP & ELPAC Score Overview Site council reviewed comparison test results for the State of California, Sutter County, and Marcum for ELA, Math, Science, and English Language Proficiency. Marcum's overall achievement levels were stronger than that of the state and county, but strategic focus areas for continued growth include science, interventions for students not meeting standard for ELA/math, and ongoing language development supports.
 - b. CalHOPE Social Emotional Learning Grant
 Marcum has been selected to be 1 in 4 grant recipients in Sutter County to focus
 on supporting social emotional learning. Site council provided input on potential
 parent-nights to be offered. Comments included the preference for and
 accessibility of Zoom, and its ability to be recorded and accessed at alternative
 times, as well as that a topic of interest for families with younger students would
 be helping their child manage emotions.
 - c. Family Engagement Opportunities Site council continued discussion from the previous meeting about the desire to rekindle staff/family connections that were affected by Covid restrictions. Potential face to face connection opportunity ideas include varied, casual coffee with admin dates, newly returned sporting events, rotating staff representation at Parents Club events (before starting?). Site council suggested surveying to see

what connection opportunities families may be interested in, and offering house points as an incentive for attendance at opportunities like coffee with admin.
